

Sizing for Beginner Violin

Providing your beginner violin student with an appropriately sized instrument for their size is essential for proper technical development, physical comfort and safety. Use the chart below to measure for correct size instrument on which to start your beginning violinist.



To measure:

1. Fully extend left arm to left of body with palm open.
2. Using a measuring tape or yardstick, measure from middle of left palm to neck.

Player between sizes, select the smaller instrument.

K	5-6	Min. 16"	1/8
1	6-7	Min. 18"	1/4
2	7-8	Min. 18"	1/4
3	8-9	Min. 20"	1/2
4	9-10	Min. 20"	1/2
5	10-11	Min. 22"	3/4
6	11-12	Min. 22"	3/4
7-Adult	12 +	Min. 23" +	4/4
